<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Absolute sovereignty and omnipotence of God • Predestination • Believed God had saved followers of Calvinism • High standards of morality • Genevan Catechism- set of questions and answers, guide to church document • Women had participation in church, but men still held all power 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only adults could make a choice about religious choice, baptism, and entrance into Christian Community • No child baptism • Religious toleration- “not everyone can see the light” • Women admitted into ministry • Pacifism • Separation of Church and state 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clerical celibacy • Confession • Transubstantiation • Under Mary- went back to Roman Catholicism • Elizabeth- did not care what people believed as long as they kept quiet about it • Elizabeth- 39 Articles= basic tenets of Anglican Church • Protestant direction but remained traditional
